PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to maintain a safe working environment at all fire stations.

Personnel shall be responsible to follow all departmental and manufacturer guidelines concerning the safe use of equipment or products.

POLICY

Each member of the department is responsible to report any safety hazard to the officer in charge. The officer in charge shall be responsible to neutralize or cause to neutralize any and all safety hazards.

Eye Protection

Goggles are to be worn anytime personnel are using grinders, weed eaters, chemicals or anytime the possibility of causing an injury to the eyes exist.

Hand Protection

Anytime chemicals are being used the appropriate hand protection shall be worn.

Checking Vehicles

Anytime personnel are working under an apparatus or any vehicle the brakes are to be set and the wheels chocked.

Ladders

Personnel shall not be on a ladder without other personnel scotching the ladder.

Other Hazards

Other hazards are encountered during daily maintenance of stations and equipment and it is each person's responsibility to use good judgment to ensure their personal safety.
