SUBJECT: Automatic Aid Agreement between the Russellville Fire Department and the Linker Mountain Fire District for Initial Response to Reported Structure Fires at the Club House of the Russellville Country Club

Per the request of the fire chief of the Linker Mountain Fire Department, it is requested that your office revise the current automatic aid response assignment to the club house of the Russellville Country Club in the event of a reported structure fire at that location. The revision for the initial structural dispatch is to include one engine company and a battalion chief from the Russellville Fire Department. As is the norm for automatic or mutual aid, the need for additional RFD resources would be determined by the responding battalion chief upon their arrival on the scene.

Fire Station 3 is the closest RFD station to the location and therefore Engine 3 will serve as the primary RFD engine company for the initial response. The hierarchical order of engine companies for the assignment in the event the primary engine is not available is to be the same as nearby "in city" responses.
