The First Order of Business was a Public Hearing requesting approval to review and approve a Special Use Permit to locate a communication tower in a C-2, at 105 Skyline Drive, submitted by Craig Turner on behalf of JV Properties. (SP.10.09.80)

Mr. Turner stated that JV Properties was requesting approval to remove an existing 60' tower and erect a 100' tower at a different site on their property. The higher tower is necessary to upgrade new technology and to get above surrounding trees. This tower will be used for communication between Millard-Henry Clinic and St. Mary's Hospital.

Commissioner Davenport cited his only concern would be the helicopter coming in to land at St. Mary's. Mr. Turner said he didn't think that would be a problem.

Commissioner Perkins made the motion to approve the Special Use Permit. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Sims and passed unanimously.
