City Council Report - November 2024 - RAC & M.J. Hickey Pool Report

M.J. Hickey Pool:

- The Russellville High School Swim and Dive Team practiced at the pool until 10/10 before getting too cold to swim (balance due in November \$930)
- The Boys and Girls Club of the River Valley submitted payment for 809 day passes for club members in July, and for the Sharks Swim Team program agreement (\$3,372.00)

RAC:

- Party Rentals: 27 half room, full room and private parties (\$4,325)
- New and renewed memberships for the month of October totaled 110 (\$7,162)
- Daily admissions: 11 and under = 295, 12 and up = 375 (\$3,478)
- Classes and programs: 3 water fitness classes (\$3,499)
- Cub Scout Pack 182 Swim Test and Water Adventure led by Head Guard Edwyn Brock
- Stroke development training for lifeguards led by certified water safety instructors Dalton Bloodworth and Lead Guard Landon Daily. The 4 week development classes promoted more efficient strokes leading to less fatigue for our guards while we continue to ensure the safety of our patrons.
- Piney Creeks Chapter of the Arkansas Canoe Club started their fall and winter roll classes.
- Kids Fest participation: group effort candy donations, building the game frame, painting, delivering and hosting the games (Facilities Maintenance, Recreation and Parks, Patrons, Lifeguards and student volunteers)
- 2nd Friday Water Polo continues to bring in new players and we are hopeful for an informal league to develop.
- RHS Swim and Dive team has 23 members. They moved to the RAC for practice and held their first swim meet. The Red and Black Scrimmage was the pre-season time trials for the team. Five of our lifeguards raced the high school team and performed very well!
