Events & Community Partnerships

- Hosted the Pope County Search and Rescue team on February 16th.
- Morrilton Scuba School conducted a diver-in-distress rescue demonstration on February 23rd.
- Hosted Arkansas Tech University ROTC cadets on February 11th for water-based training exercises.
- The 4-H Robotics Club utilized the pool every Wednesday in February to test underwater robotics projects.

Participation across programs remained steady and diverse, serving youth, adults, seniors, and specialized groups.

For February, we sold a total of 281 day passes generating a total of \$2,713.

Membership renewals and insurance reimbursement for the month reached \$7,034.

Classes and Programs generated a total of \$5,535.

In terms of Rentals, 31 Half Room events, 5 Full Room events, and 11 Private Parties were booked, generating a total of \$5,220. These rentals are scheduled between February 2026 and April 2026
