

## Recreation & Parks Department Report August 2019

- Twelve groups used the Hughes Center during July for a total of 123 hours. Events included a Hard Rock Casino meet and greet, the Arkansas Single Parent Scholarship Fund Pope and Yell Counties fundraiser and a USA Powerlifting competition.
- For the month of July there were 17 regular parties and 10 private party at the aquatic center for a total of 64 hours. Classes in July included Try Scuba, Water Aerobics, Silver Fins, and Aqua Zumba for total of 27 hours. Swim lesson classes were held for a total of 75 hours. The aquatic center was the host site for the Boys and Girls Club Sharks swim meet on July 12
