

Thank you for having your party with us at the Russellville Aquatic Center. Below is a list of rules we need to go over to make sure we make the Russellville Aquatic Center a fun and safe place for all of our patrons! Please sign and date below after you have thoroughly read the party rules. We hope you enjoy your time with us at the Russellville Aquatic Center!

Pool Party Rules

- Pool Parties are scheduled on a first come, first served basis. Reservations will be made only by visiting our pool office. Party host must sign a liability waiver form and the rules at the pool office.
- All reservations will be secured with a nonrefundable payment in full. There is a \$10 administration fee for any date changes.
- The Aquatic Center will call the party host 24 hours in advance of the party to confirm the reservation.
- All guests, swimming or not, over the twenty (20) or forty (40) guests included in the reservation are required to pay a \$5 admission fee. This does not apply to a Private Party.
- Party host is responsible for food and beverages for the party, and the party host is able to bring in a birthday cake/cupcakes. **All food must remain in the party rooms at all times with the exception of bottled water.**
- Party host is responsible for all paper goods for the party. This includes plates, napkins, forks, cups, tablecloths, etc. Party host is also able to decorate the party area. **However, no piñatas, confetti or candles allowed.**
- No glass containers allowed; alcohol and tobacco are not allowed on the property.
- No heating elements allowed; this includes crock pots, grills, hot plates, etc. No cooking allowed (inside or outside).
- All party areas must be cleared out ten (10) minutes before the end of the party time.
- You may arrive ten (10) minutes prior to the party time to set up and decorate.
- All children not potty-trained must be in a swim diaper and swimsuit. Floaties and similar inflatable devices are not allowed; only Coast Guard approved lifejackets allowed.
- All guests who will be swimming must be in appropriate swimwear attire. This includes bathing suits, swim trunks and specifically made rash-guard swim shirts. Cut-offs, gym shorts, sports bras, and t-shirts are not proper swim attire.
- Party host is responsible for cleaning up after the party. Please dispose of all trash and food in the trash bin located in the party room. A lifeguard will provide a broom, dust pan, paper towels and cleaning supplies for you to utilize.
- All Russellville Aquatic Center general rules also apply with the exception of rule 16.

I have read the above rules and agree to abide by such. I understand that if any of the above rules are not followed my party could be asked to leave the premises. I understand that if my party is asked to leave due to not following any of the party rules or general rules of the Aquatic Center, I will not be issued any kind of refund.
